SolidCAD supports various government programs to boost productivity through technology adoption. Our training facilities are accredited by the Labor Market Commission and all of our courses meet the requirements of the Act.

The Canada Job Grant helps employers train new or existing employees for jobs that need to be filled. This flexible program is designed to meet the needs of businesses of all sizes, in all industries and regions. Having the right skills helps employees excel and succeed in today's fast-paced labour market.

- Launched in 2014 as a 6-year initiative, this training grant is a segment of the \$300M/year Canada Job Grant initiative as part of Canada's Economic Action Plan.
- The COJG was created provide training to Canadian employees in order to improve their employability and in-demand skill-sets.
- Employers with fewer than 50 employees can qualify for up to 83% coverage, to a maximum of \$10,000 per person in government support for training costs.
- Employers with 51 or more employees can qualify for up to 66% coverage, to a maximum of \$10,000 per person in government support for training costs.
